April and May are the peak visit months, and classes, films and planetarium shows fill up quickly. If you plan to visit in April or May, it's best to make a reservation at least eight weeks in advance, and no less than two weeks in advance, in order to reserve the dates, times and programs of your choice. You have a reservation only if you have received a reservation confirmation, which will be mailed to you as quickly as possible. At this time of year, the volume of requests greatly increase. Most requests are processed within eight working days. You must bring the confirmation with you the day of your visit.

Note that the Science Museum is closed on Mondays.
